### **Participation Expectations for Munster Lego League:**

- Be on time for the meeting – For safety, doors will be locked at 7:15
- Pick up time is at 8:30pm
- If you are absent, please bring in a note from an adult stating why you were unable to attend the meeting and contact your coach
- Work on the task your coach assigns to you
- Electronic games are not permitted

### **Three Strikes Policy:**

You are required to follow the behavior expectations as indicated in the School Town of Munster handbook. There will be a three-strike behavior policy. Parents or guardians will be contacted and informed if you have been disruptive to the meeting and have reached three strikes. Since you will no longer be able to participate in the meeting, your parent or guardian will be required to pick you up.

### **Three Absences Policy:**

If you are unable to attend a meeting, please provide a note stating why you were unable to attend. Because we are meeting twice a week and are trying to qualify for state competition, attendance is a must. After the third unexcused absence it will be determined if you are able to continue on with your team. If you are not attending the meetings, your team has to work much harder to make up for the lost work from the student; this has a direct impact on the entire team.

### **Team work Policy**

You are working as a member on a team. The coach will give assigned tasks to each member on each day. You are to act in a responsible manner and perform the task you are assigned. If you refuse to participate on a task your parent or guardian will be contacted to pick you up. If you continue to not perform the tasks that are assigned to you by the coach, you will be removed from the team. Remember if you are not doing your share, your team has to work that much harder to make up for lost brainpower, ideas, and assembly of your project. You are also judged on teamwork at the competition.

### **Team equipment**

Each team is assigned robot and mission field equipment. The team is responsible for the care of the equipment. Team equipment damage will result in that team not participating in competition.
