



# MUNSTER LEGO LEAGUE REGISTRATION

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## Description of Munster Lego League

Munster Lego League is the school's organization which competes in FIRST LEGO League (FLL). FLL is made up of regional, state, and a national robot competitions in which Munster students, grades 4<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> will have 8 weeks to solve a series of problems provided and set by FLL on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The teams will gain hands-on experience in basic science and engineering principles as they construct and program their machines using a LEGO Mindstorms robotic development kits.

Each team with a maximum of 8 students will be responsible for completing three tasks required for competition: formal project presentation, mechanical design, and programming. These three tasks MUST all be completed to compete at an event.

*Due to the number of students that attend, and the need for multiple coaches per team, parents are needed to coach or assist each team or the number of teams will be reduced. Two coaches per team at each meeting are required.*

Meetings will be held on Mondays and Thursdays from 7:00p.m. until 8:30p.m. at Wilbur Wright Middle School. The amount of time per week has been demonstrated to be the 'minimum' amount of time required for a team to prepare for competition. Additional time will likely be needed as the competition date approaches. Regional competition will occur in mid November and state competition (if qualified) will occur in mid December.
